The project promotes awareness of the EU and European parliamentary democracy and aims to bring knowledge about the functioning of the European Union and the European Parliament to young people. Through various activities, students and their mentors discover what it means to be a European citizen, the advantages of membership in everyday life, learn about the role of the European Parliament and other institutions in the decision-making process, and the importance of active citizenship for the future of the EU.

We have already participated in the project in the previous school year (2022/23) and after the completion of the project, we obtained the title 'Ambassador School of the European Parliament'. The project is intended for all students and it takes place from October 2023 to June 2024.
